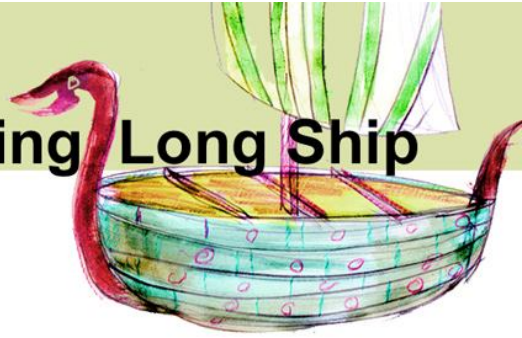

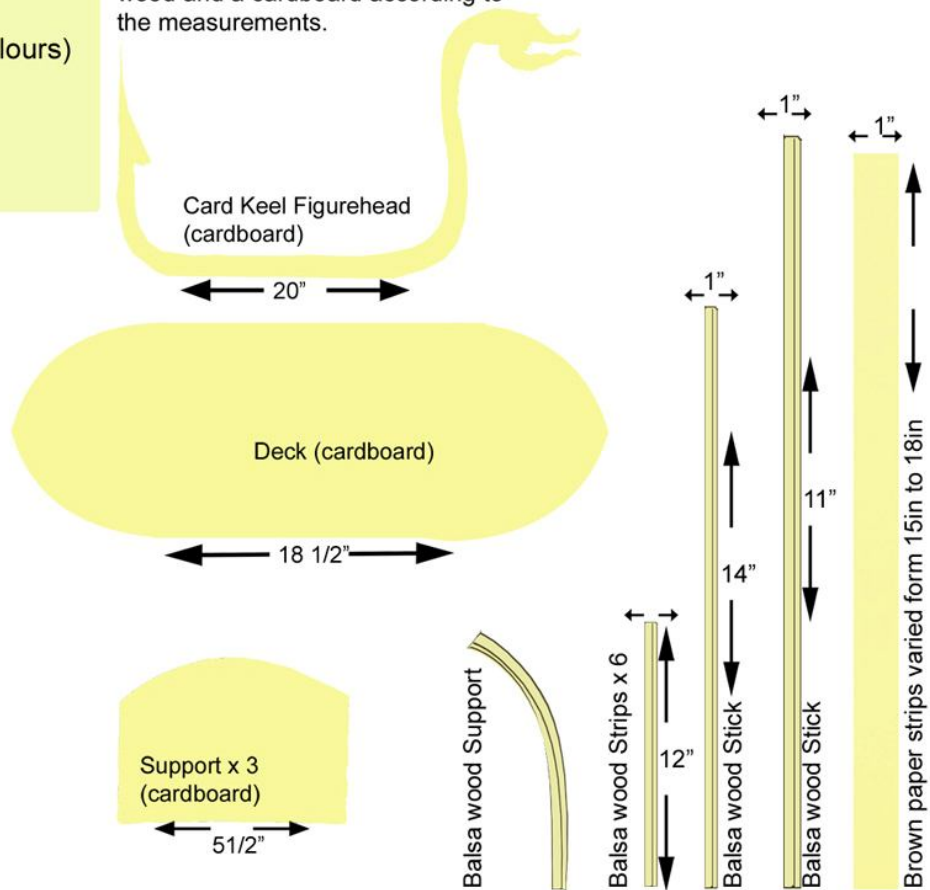
Thick card  
Balsa wood  
Wooden stick  
Brown card Sheet  
Paper

Scissors  
Acrylic paints (3 Colours)  
Glue  
Paint brush  
Masking tape  
String

# Build a Viking Long Ship

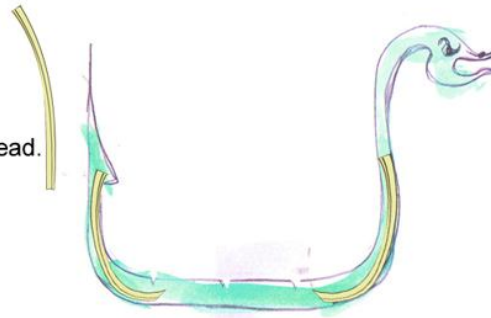


## Templates

Ask an adult to cut a piece of balsa wood and a cardboard according to the measurements.

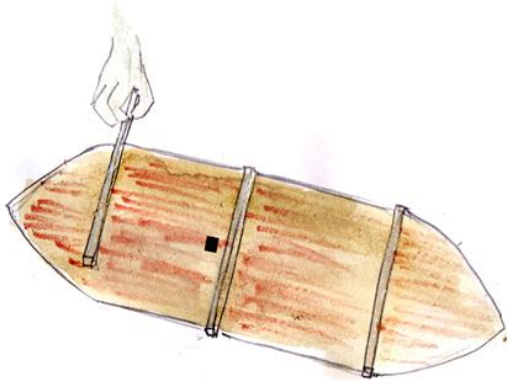


1. Glue two curved balsa stripes to the curved parts of the keel as shown. This will strengthen the keel and the figure head.

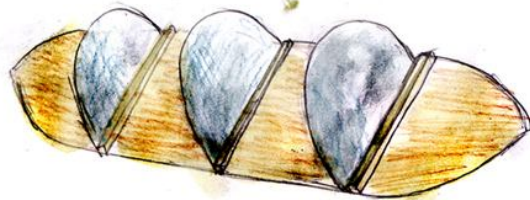
2. Paint the two sides of the wood in two different colours, here, brown and mustard



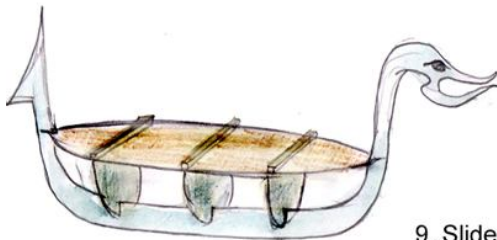
3. Make a small square hole for the mast.

4. You could also draw lines 1/4 inches apart on the brown side for a wooden deck effect.

5. Glue on three balsa wooden strips of 5 1/2 inches as shown in the diagram



6. Glue another three balsa wooden strips on the other side of the card (mustard side) matching them with the planks on the brown side.

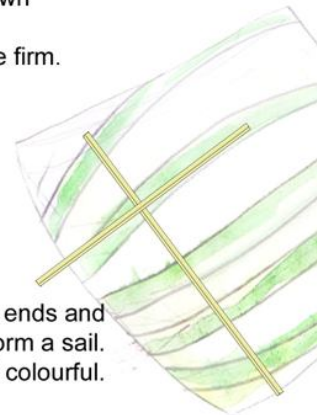


7. Stick the three card supports, the cross beams.

8. Make three slots using scissors along the length, each matching the cross beams on the deck card.

9. Slide the cross beams into the slots as shown and glue them in place. Also use masking tape so that the joints are firm.

10. Make a mast using 12 inches long balsa wood and another 14 inches long wooden stick. Glue them or bind them with strings to form a cross.



11. Stick a rectangular piece of thick paper at the ends and in the middle of the cross to form a sail. Make it bright and colourful.



12. Add a pair of eyes to the figure head.

13. Using paper strips of varied lengths, widths and colours glued to each other, cover the sides of the ship.
